A new modern crematorium has been proposed to give bereaved families in and around Leeds and Wakefield more choice, longer service times, and greater opportunities for personalised funeral services, all delivered with exceptional care. Plus, for the first time locally, it will also offer the increasingly popular option of a natural burial. The plans have been drawn up by **Westerleigh Group**, one of the UK's largest independent owners and operators of crematoria and cemeteries. Westerleigh Group wishes to build a modern crematorium and natural burial ground on a 20-acre site in **Oulton**, six miles southeast of Leeds and five miles north of Wakefield, bringing the exceptional care it has built its reputation on to local communities. Ian McArdle, Westerleigh Group's chief property officer, said: "There is presently no provision on the eastern side of Leeds. We believe those communities, along with those in the surrounding areas, would benefit from having the choice of a new modern crematorium and natural burial ground." Mayo undertakers David McGowan and his daughter Bridín have completed the opening of a new crematorium in Collooney, Co. Sligo - the first of its type in the west of Ireland. Eleven cremations have taken place at the facility since it opened over two weeks ago. The crematorium is operated by well known Sligo funeral undertaking firm, Foley and McGowan. The new facility is one that is faithful to the traditions of how grieving families say farewell to their loved ones in a most peaceful setting. David, who also has an undertaking business in Ballina, decided to convert a storeroom into a very tasteful crematorium that can cater for up to 120 mourners who can say goodbye to their loved ones in a warm homely setting. A bid to create a new crematorium for Hindu and Sikh funerals has been turned down by councillors. Applicants **CDS Group** applied for planning permission to demolish a late 19th century farmhouse and outbuildings in **East Scraptoft**. The application, planned for Scraptoft Lodge Farm in Keyham Lane, attracted 56 letters of support and 30 objections, the Local Democracy Reporting Service said. But the proposal was refused by a planning committee at Harborough District Council on the grounds that the development would be too large and not fit in with the surrounding area. CDS's application included two chapels, which would have held six ceremonies a day between them. Supporters of the bid said it would foster inclusivity, but opponents raised objections about the design, parking and any extra traffic funeral processions would create. Donegal's first crematorium has been granted planning permission. Donegal County Council has given the green light to Michael Morning for the construction of the facility in **Letterkenny**. Mr Morning is planning to build a crematorium within a proposed funeral home at Carnamuggagh. Plans for the funeral home were previously granted planning permission and in December a fresh application was lodged to add a crematorium to the facility. Mr Morning, who owns the nearby Eternal Light Chapel of Rest, has been granted planning permission, subject to 20 conditions laid down by the Council. The local authority has sought information regarding the training proposals for operational staff and the arrangements for the disposal of waste arising. It has also asked for a detailed monitoring programme for stakeholders emissions. Various assessments and reports are also required by the Council before construction of the facility can begin. The applicant is to use 'best practicable means' to prevent or minimise noise and dust emissions during the construction and the operational phases of the development. Construction can only take place between 7am-7pm Monday-Friday, 8am-2pm on Saturdays and not at all on Sundays or public holidays. The hours of operation will be between 9.30am-6pm seven days a week.
